#### Stuff to Do Around Brickyard Plantation RV Park, Americus GA (Dec 2024)

Andersonville National Historic Site, 760 POW Rd, Andersonville, GA A museum and grounds chronicling the infamous horrible Civil War prison and a still active National Cemetery. In town, there is a Confederate Monument of Col Henry Wirz, one of only two people tried, convicted and hanged for Civil War crimes. (The other being Champ Ferguson, who was a renegade in middle TN).

Andersonville General Store and Mama's Kitchen is "downtown" Andersonville by the Wirz monument. Exit the National Park on Pecan Rd and go straight across Hwy 49. It turns into Church St. Drive until you see the monument in the road. Parking nearby for <u>Andersonville General Store and Mama's Kitchen</u>, and some shops.

Historic theater opened 1921, renovated 1999.

Folks of all backgrounds, faiths and those struggling with faith have been visiting Koinonia Farm from all over the world since our founding in 1942. It's a peaceful place to rest, a community that's committed to peace and social justice, and a working farm with animals, gardens, orchards, walking trails, a store and a museum. It's also the birthplace of Clarence Jordan's writings, Habitat for Humanity, the Fuller Center for Housing, Jubilee Partners and many other organizations and causes. 

## Diamond Railroad Crossing, Oglethorpe GA. (google map) - drive to the end of Crescent street from east side of tracks, not west),

This whimsical 10 minute stop, 25 miles from campground on the way to Yoder's restaurant, has one of an apparently unknown number of "level junctions" (AKA "diamond crossing") in the US where two tracks cross without a bridge. Oglethorpe BBQ is also nearby!

On the <u>georgia railroad map I found</u>, the east/west track is labeled CSXT and the more north/south track is NS (Norfolk Southern). The more east/west track is CSX acquisition from the historic <u>ATLANTA</u>, <u>BIRMINGHAM & COAST (ABC) RAILROAD</u>.

If a train comes by while you are there, and you get excited, you can claim official "Foamer" status. Warning: Last visit you could just drive into the rail yard. Not sure if/when they may close it to public. Watch out for metal debris laying around.
