## **HOST/HOSTESS**

If you sign up to host a rally please make it fun and do what you want to do. There is no rhyme or reason to be a Rally Host.

- Your budget is based on the number of rally attendees at \$10 per person. Visitors do not pay. KEEP ALL RECEIPTS AND GIVE TO Linda Underwood with the Rally reimbursement form. If Linda is not attending please give to Wayne Mickey.
- 2. Most people do a night out at a local restaurant (this is not mandatory.) Make reservations a least a couple weeks in advance of the rally. This entails making reservations at said restaurant and giving them approximate number attending. Usually 5:00 p.m. is the seating time. Stay inContact with restaurants after Meet and Greet with final numbers.
- Some people have suggested doing a pot luck dinner one of the nights. The main course (meat, soups, chilis, etc.), can be part of the budget or sometimes other members donate it. Order the main course if the Host/Hostess is providing.
- 4. The Meet and Greet is the official beginning of the Rally. The Host/Hostess sets the time on Wednesday. Have a signup sheet for those attending restaurant, activity, pot luck and Sunday breakfast. Tablecloths and decorations are not paid for by the club. Handouts with a list of local restaurants or outings are helpful to those attending but not mandatory. Wayne will hold the meeting.
- 5. A case of water should be bought and put in the room and offered to the group for any of the gatherings and/or evenings of game playing.
- 6. Sunday breakfast is open to whatever. The food could be bought breakfast/sausage biscuits, muffins, donuts, or even homemade casseroles or muffins. Make sure there is enough coffee in the tubs and Wayne usually will make it Sunday morning.
